The process for determining the winning bid for the bus will be the following:

- 1) School board officially votes to surplus a school bus, which has been fully depreciated according to state guidelines. Bus was surplus on July 18, 2023.
- 2) A 30-day period of time elapses prior to advertising the surplus sale.
- 3) The bus surplus sale is posted on the website and in a public setting.
- 4) A window of time (one month) is given for all interested parties to submit email bids for the surplus bus sale.
- 5) We collect the bids via email thale@index.k12.wa.us
- 6) We will award the sale to the highest bidder in the sealed-bid process.
- 7) All sales are final and all associated costs and liabilities are assumed by the new owner.

The official beginning of our surplus bidding will begin Monday Sept. 11, 2023 and end Sept. 29, 2023. Minimum bid on bus #8 will start at \$1,500.00. Lower bids will not be accepted. Any questions please send to the email thale@index.k12.wa.us
